In the overview below we have combined as much of the typical scope for each treatment into a package so you have a good idea of a baseline price. We also show a price range for the medication required. Our pricing structure is designed to ensure that you have access to the best possible care while making your fertility journey as affordable as possible.

As much as we would like to create all-in-packages, each patient's journey is unique, so we create a personalised treatment plan tailored to your individual needs. Use the following prices as guidelines so you know what to expect. The list is not exhaustive but shows the most common items. Sometimes a fertility plan includes specialist diagnostics or additional medicine we can provide but don't list here.

As part of our medical consultation we will provide you with a fully costed fertility plan based on your personal and specific situation. With your personal treatment plan you can compare like-for-like. Make sure you get a fully costed plan prior to you committing to any treatment. When you are provided with a quote, ask what is included and - equally important - what will be charged extra.

An important point on medication which can be a material share of the total cost: The estimate for medications is based on the treatment plan but may vary depending on the pharmacy and the availability of medication at the time of treatment. We provide our patients with access to pharmacies that honour our discounted prices, ensuring that prescriptions are filled and medications are delivered efficiently.

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Consultations

The first step in any fertility journey is to have a medical consultation with a fertility doctor. They will conduct an ultrasound scan on the female partner to make sure your ovaries and other reproductive organs are healthy. They will get to know you, understand your goals and timeline, and make an initial recommendation after reviewing your scans. They will initiate tests (see next page) and use the results to confirm your personalized fertility plan.

Diagnosics & Screenings

Female fertility test

Essential female fertility test

We need blood samples to check the important biomarkers that help estimate estimate the current fertility potential:

- AMH (Anti-Muellerian Hormone): The levels of this hormone found inside the cells in the ovaries' follicles help estimate egg supply and ovarian reserve
- TSH (Thyroid Stimulating Hormone): Abnormal TSH levels indicate thyroid dysfunction, which can disrupt ovulation and menstrual cycles, affecting fertility
- Vitamin D plays a role in follicular development, egg quality and pregnancy success.

You have two options to provide the blood sample for testing, at our clinic or at home

Sometimes the medical history, ultrasound scan or essential blood test require further diagnostic tests - especially if the recommended treatment is IVF. These tests can include assessing the fallopian tubes to ensure they are not blocked, the uterine cavity to rule out any abnormalities like polyps or fibroids, and the endometrium (uterine lining) to optimize the chances of successful embryo implantation. Dr Kat will advise you if you need any of these and if so, explain in detail.

Male fertility test

Essential male fertility test

Fertility tests are important for any gender. We need semen sample to conduct two important tests to evaluate a man's fertility potential:

- Semen Analysis: We aim to understand sperm quantity and quality by testing parameters such as semen volume, concentration (count), motility (movement), morphology (shape)
- Semen Culture checks for infections that negatively impact sperm quality, motility, and overall fertility potential.

In specific scenarios, further male fertility tests are needed even though the essential male fertility test results are normal. Dr Kat will discuss with you if this applies to you, but examples include if the couple has struggling to conceive and female fertility is sound, if you have suffered from miscarriages or recurrent pregnancy loss, or if the male partner has certain risk factors such as varicocele, chronic diseases, advanced age or lifestyle factors.

Pre-treatment Screening Blood Tests

Mandatory tests included in treatment packages

Every patient undergoing IVF, ICSI, Egg Freezing, or IUI treatments require virology screening blood tests (HIV, Hepatitis B (HBsAg, Anti-HBc), Hepatitis C), as well as Chlamydia and Gonorrhoea.

These tests are needed for both partners.

The female partner also needs a proof of immunity to Rubella.

These tests must be within 3 months of a first treatment cycle and then repeated every 2 years for any subsequent cycles.

As most patients have not done those tests before we are including those in the treatment package price. However, those tests may be performed through your GP.

If you can provide valid pathology test results from a ISO 15189 accredited laboratory we can reduce the fees accordingly, by up to £680.

Fertility Treatments

Ovulation Induction & Timed Intercourse

Ovulation induction with timed intercourse is a less invasive and more affordable first-line approach for many couples that might not need IVF.

This involves Dr Kat prescribing medication to encourage ovulation. This medication can help regulate or induce ovulation in women who have irregular or absent menstrual cycles, or who have conditions such as polycystic ovary syndrome (PCOS) that can affect ovulation. To monitor the impact of the medication on the ovaries, Dr Kat will conduct ultrasound scans and blood tests following the commencement of the medication.

Combining ovulation induction with timed intercourse, i.e. having sexual intercourse at the most fertile time of the woman's menstrual cycle, the chances of fertilisation and pregnancy are increased.

- If the treatment is abandoned before the first mid-cycle scan is scheduled, we will refund you £250.

Fertility Treatments

IUI - Intrauterine Insemination

This fertility treatment involves injecting prepared sperm directly into the uterus to increase the chances of fertilization. IUI can be a good treatment option for couples who have unexplained infertility, mild male factor infertility, or cervical factor infertility.

In most cases, the person who will carry the pregnancy takes fertility medication to boost egg production, although it is also possible to go through IUI during a normal menstrual cycle. Throughout the course of a few weeks, the person carrying the pregnancy will go to the clinic for a series of monitoring appointments. Dr Kat will keep an eye on follicle growth, which determines how many eggs can develop and release.

When the time is right, the carrying partner will be given a hormonal injection to help the eggs mature and ovulate. On that same day, sperm from either a male partner or donor will be washed and prepared to choose the best quality sperm. Then, a doctor will inject the best sperm into the female partner's uterus, which can sound scary but isn't typically painful.

Cancellation and Refund policy for the IUI cycles:

- If the treatment cycle is abandoned during stimulation and before the insemination procedure is scheduled, we will refund you £1010.
- Patients will be charged for blood tests that have been performed and any medications that have been dispensed up to the date of cycle cancellation, as these are not refundable under any circumstances.
- If you can provide valid pathology test results from a ISO 15189 accredited laboratory we can reduce the fees accordingly, by up to £680.

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Fertility Treatments

IVF (in vitro fertilization)/ICSI Treatments

The majority of our patients require an IVF (in vitro fertilization) treatment plans to help couples and individuals achieve their dream of having a family. IVF is a process where eggs are collected from the ovaries and fertilized with sperm in a laboratory, before being transferred back into the uterus.

As every patient is different it is important to craft a truly **personalised treatment plan** rather than relying on clinic-wide standard protocols. This requires senior clinician expertise but is critical for a positive outcome.

One acronym often shown as separate price item is ICSI (intracytoplasmic sperm injection), a technique where a single sperm is injected directly into an egg to assist with fertilization. At Dr Kat Fertility, we include **ICSI as default** in our IVF packages in order to increase the chance of a cycle being successful, without the need for repeated procedures. If ICSI is not used, the cost will be refunded to you.

We also include freezing of additional embryos selected and embryo storage for a year so you make the most of your cycle.

The types and amounts of medication used can differ significantly from patient to patient, so we provide price ranges only to reflect this individualized approach.

If your fertility plan suggests that you will need multiple cycles, we will provide discounted multi-cycle packages as part of our IVF treatment options but we will not encourage you to commit upfront if there is a good chance that you can get pregnant within two cycles.

“We have made great efforts to make the price list digestible but it is normal to have many questions as the topic is personal and complicated. Cancellation and Refund policy for an IVF cycle:

- If the cycle is abandoned before the trigger injection has been made, we will refund you £4 870.
- If the cycle is abandoned because of premature ovulation on the day of egg collection or if no eggs are collected or no mature eggs are found, we will provide you a partial refund, which includes fees for the extended blastocyst culture, embryo assessment, fresh embryo transfer, HFEA Fee, and ICSI (£1450).
- If there is a failure at the fertilisation/cleavage stages, we will provide a partial refund, which includes fees for the extended blastocyst culture, fresh embryo transfer, and HFEA Fee (£450).
- Any blood tests performed, and medications dispensed during the treatment cycle are not refundable under any circumstances.
- For each treatment package we have indicated those items that are included in the pre-paid treatment package but are refundable if the doctor determines that they are not needed.
- There is no refund offered in the event of no eggs being collected, fertilisation failure or nothing suitable for freezing. There is no refund offered if a cycle is unsuccessful.

- We use a non-interrupted time-lapse imaging incubator (Embryoscope) to culture the embryos. We routinely plan to culture all embryos to day 5. If the culture beyond day 3 does not take place we will provide a refund for this.
- We include the ICSI cost in the the pre-paid package to have the possibility to do a rescue ICSI, but in case the procedure does not take place, we will refund you £750.
- In case the cycle does not result in extra embryos that can be stored, we will refund you the fee for embryo freezing and storage £800.

- If the cycle is abandoned because of premature ovulation on the day of egg collection or if no eggs are collected or no mature eggs are found, you will be eligible for a partial refund, which includes fees for the extended blastocyst culture, embryo assessment, embryo freezing.
- If there is a failure on the fertilisation/cleavage stages, you will be eligible for a partial refund, which includes fees for the extended blastocyst culture, embryo freezing.

[^] Eggs are provided by a partner egg donor bank. Prices for eggs are charged directly and vary between donor eggs and the number of eggs used.

The more eggs (oocytes) used, the better as the chances of success rise progressively with the number of eggs used - referred to as Cumulative Live Birth Rate "CLBR" : The CLBR with 5 oocytes is only 6.1%, **with 12 oocytes the CLBR is 53.4%**.

All eggs have been screened for infectious diseases and quarantined for a 3 month period in accordance with HFEA guidance. ECS report available on selected donors.

Frozen Embryo Transfer (FET) is a crucial add-on treatment for patients who have previously created and frozen embryos with us, as well as for those who have embryos stored at other clinics. When you are ready to take the next step towards parenthood, we can proceed with the implantation of these frozen embryos.

We offer the flexibility to transfer embryos stored in other clinics, whether they are located in London, elsewhere in the UK, or even abroad. Couriering embryos from other clinics is a very common practice nowadays, ensuring that you have the freedom to choose the best setting for your embryo transfer.
